The YCP Summer Music Experience offers a local opportunity for the interested high school musician to improve skills and knowledge through master classes, chamber ensembles and a broad range of elective classes. Included in the weeklong camp will be daily theory and ear training classes, composition seminars, chamber ensembles, master classes with resident and guest faculty, and workshops on practice habits, stage fright, successful auditioning and career opportunities for musicians.

Gretchen Dekker-Elicker: Artistic Director, received a master's degree with high academic honors and special recognition for distinction in performance from the New England Conservatory of Music. She currently serves as an adjunct professor of piano and solfège and a staff accompanist on the faculty of York College. She has been featured as a soloist with the Peabody Chamber Symphony, the York Symphony Orchestra, the Harrisburg Symphony, the York Oratorio Society, the Newtown Chamber Orchestra and the Concertante Chamber Ensemble.

Dr. Kenneth Osowski: Music Theory and Piano Studies, holds a doctoral degree from Peabody, a master's degree from the University of Nevada, Reno, and a bachelor's degree from Yale University. He currently serves as assistant professor of Music at York College of Pennsylvania, and coordinator of Piano and Music Theory Studies and has also served on the music theory faculties of the Peabody Conservatory and Johns Hopkins University. Osowski has performed chamber music at the Tanglewood Music Center, the Yellow Barn Festival, Carnegie Hall's Weill Hall, and the Kennedy Center's Millennium Stage.

Dr. Grace Muzzo: Vocal Coordinator, holds degrees from Gordon College and Westminster Choir College and a DMA in Conducting from the University of Georgia. She is a member of the music faculty at York College of Pennsylvania directing the choral program and teaching courses in music education and conducting. Muzzo maintains an active membership in the American Choral Directors Association, The National Association for Music Education, and has adjudicated and taken voice students to auditions for the National Association of Teachers of Singing.

Susan Loy: Administrative Director, holds a BME in music education from Susquehanna University and the MM in Performance from Indiana University School of Music, Bloomington. She currently serves as Adjunct Professor of Music at York College of Pennsylvania, teaching clarinet and saxophone, woodwind methods, music appreciation and music in film. Active as a performer as well as an educator, Ms. Loy is a Performing Artist member of the Wednesday Club of Harrisburg, and also frequently performs in popular and jazz idioms throughout the Central PA area.
